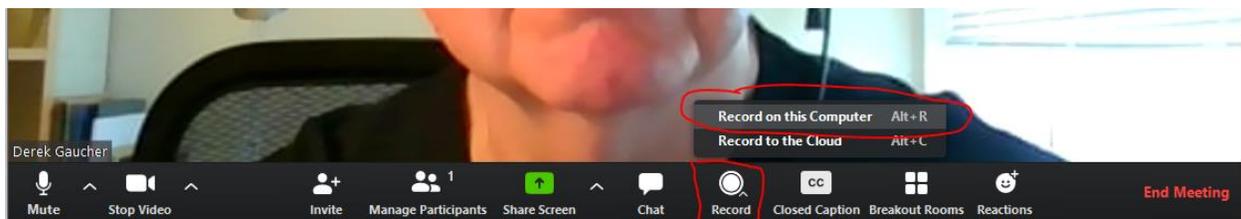

How to upload a local Zoom session recording to Microsoft Stream

The Zoom session host is presented with the options to **Record on this Computer** and **Record to the Cloud** when they click on the Record button. By default, all local recordings will be placed in a Zoom folder found in the following file path on these devices:

- PC: C:\Users\User Name\Documents\Zoom
- Mac: /Users/User Name/Documents/Zoom

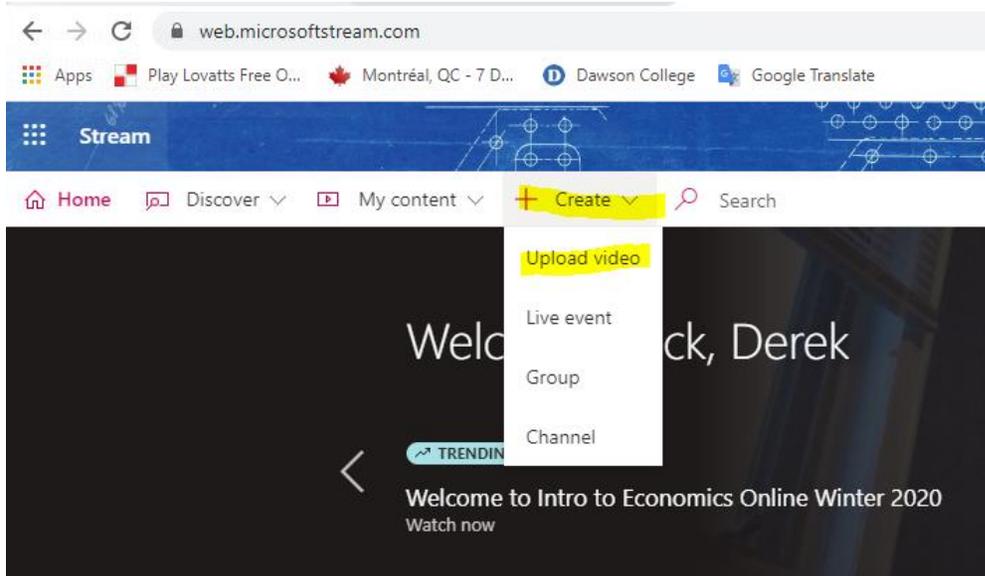
Each session recording is saved to a file folder labeled with the session date and time. The Audio/Video file is named **zoom_0.mp4** by default. Each subsequent recording is in sequential order: zoom_0, zoom_1, zoom_2, etc.



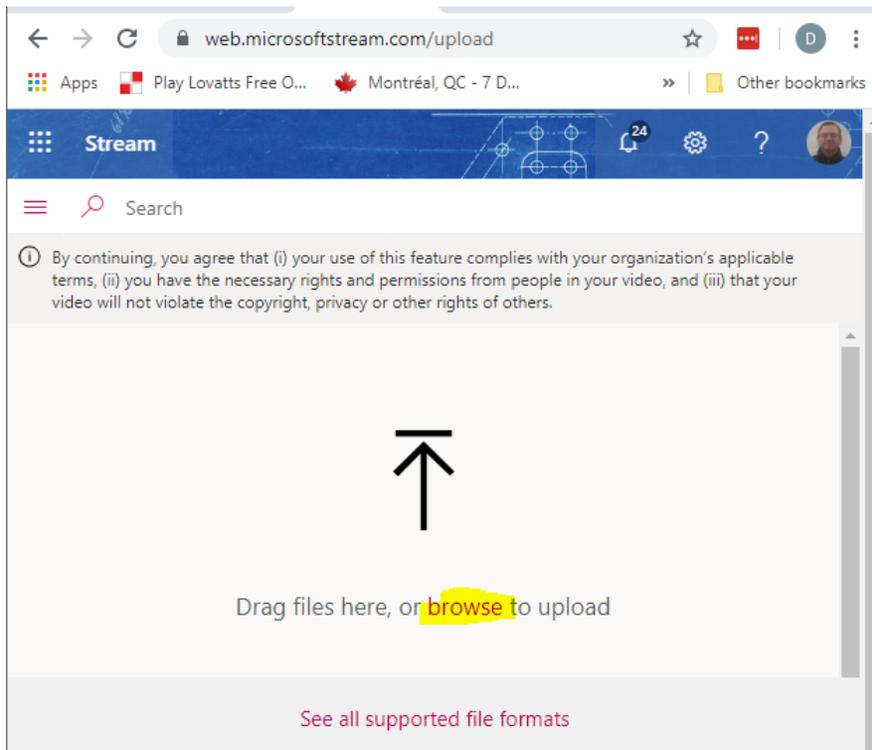
To upload a Zoom session recording to Microsoft Stream,

1. Start the Stream application
2. Click on the +Create tab (see screenshot 1)
3. Click on Upload video (see screenshot 1)
4. Drag and drop the video file or click the browse link to display file explorer and select the video file. (see screenshot 2)
5. Complete the form information and click Publish to initiate the upload. (see screenshot 3)
