Download yourself some downtime...



Materials you will need...

- I. Read over these instructions
- 2. Printout the template. You can reuse a sheet of paper or card stock
- 3. Have a palette ready. I use an old white or glass plate
- 4. Canvas or canvas board or thick cardboard 8"x 10" or 8"x 8"
- 5. 3 acrylic colours: one light (titanium white), one mid tone (blue, red, green or purple) and one dark colour (ultramarine blue or black)
- 6. Brushes in assorted sizes
- 7. Scissors
- 8. Pencil
- 9. Water container
- 10. Rag or old cloth

Preparation Instructions:


- **Step I.** Prepare your work space, cover your work surface with a plastic table cloth or white garbage bag. You may want to tape it down to keep it from moving.








Tracing & Painting Instructions:


- Step 3. Trace out your honey comb larger outer smaller inner
- **Step 4.** begin with lighter colours squares out a drop of your middle tone and a drop of your light tone
- **Step 5**. begin to paint in carefully. Painting in alternately the inside and the outside of the honey comb
- **Step 6.** repeat step 4 using your darker paint colour. In my example, I used Ultramarine Blue acrylic as my dark colour
