- While we do verify the eligibility requirements and post-award grant requirements, please note that it is your responsibility to do so as well, <u>particularly when it comes to submitting information and forms to the granting agency.</u>

### Some Dawson Research News (with more to come..!)

**Anick C. Legault (Psychology)** has won a 1-year *Individual Partnership Engage Grant* (SSHRC), to fund her oneyear project, "Post-secondary students' initiatives through social media networks during the COVID-19 pandemic: Do they help?"

**Anna-Liisa Aunio (Sociology)** and her team at Dawson's <u>Food Justice & Sustainability Hub</u> developed and disseminated a Food Justice Toolkit, in <u>French</u> and <u>English</u>, and now available on <u>Sustainable Dawson's website</u>

Anna-Liisa is the recipient of a 3-year *College and Community Social Innovation Fund (CCSIF)* grant for a project entitled "The Food Justice and Sustainability Hub".

Anna-Liisa is also Dawson's lead of a multi-million, multi-institutional, multi-year federal grant to create a Healthy Cities Research Training Platform.

**Ben Seamone** and **Richard Fournier (Mathematics)** each won a MITACS CRIA award to conduct research with a student intern.

**Elizabeth Kirkland (History)** has won a *Soutien aux équipes de recherche* grant (FRQSC). Collaborating with other institutions, Elizabeth's multi-year project is called "Savoir et capital à Montréal, 1800-2000".

Vanessa Gangai and Alison Gelinas (Physiotherapy Technology) are the recipients of a Dialogue McGill grant, for their 2-year project, "A Day in the Life: Healthcare Shadowing".

**Isabeli Pizzani Maurutto** and **Jennifer Robert**, recent Health Sciences graduates, placed third in the *Association pour la recherche au collégial* (*ARC*) province-wide competition for their project, "A Study of Cognitive Inhibition and Flexibility Using the Stroop Test", as part of their work with Dawson's Neuroscience Research Group.
