Public Disclosure of Funds 2021-2022

For 2021-2022, Dawson College was awarded \$36,045 by the Research Support Fund, which was used in the Management and Administration expenditure category, towards salary offsets for the research support staff and professional development activities in research administration.

The staff play a central role in identifying and advertising funding opportunities, ensuring grant applications are complete and admissible, tracking institutional and REB approval, ensuring compliant post-award administration and internal benchmarking, policy development, and report writing

A portion of the RSF funds awarded (\$795.05) was used for professional development activities for the Research Coordinator and Research Administration Technician. These include membership fees and participation in various research administration and professional development events offered by the Canadian Association for Research Administrators (CARA) and the Association pour la recherche au collegial (ARC).
